


The purpose of tears is to nourish and keep the cornea lubricated, blinking spreads the tears around the eye. Our tears keep the eye clear of debris. Every tear is made up from water, salts, enzymes and hormones. The ratio of contents is different depending on their purpose as we have 3 types of tears.

Basal tears are present in our eyes all the time, a barrier between the eye and the world. They are produced continually and keep the eye lubricated and free from bacteria. The basal tear is made up of 3 layers. The mucus layer keeps the tears fastened on the eye, the aqueous layer maintains hydration and blocks bacteria and the oily outer lipid layer keeps the surface eyen.

Reflex tears sometimes called the eyewash tears, will wash away any dangers from things like dust, wind, smoke or fumes from onions! These are the tears that kick into action if you suffer from allergies.

Emotional tears are triggered by a range of emotions like grief, rage, sadness or joy and are believed to be generated to stabilise the mood as they contain high levels of stress hormones.

#### Orange and apricot smoothie

Ingredients - serves 2

6 fresh apricots

2 large oranges, squeezed

120g natural yogurt or kefir

1 tsp vanilla extract

1 - 2 tbsp ground flaxseed

4 icecubes

#### Method

Place all the ingredients into a blender and blend on high speed until smooth. Divide into 2 glasses and serve immediately.

You can make with dried apricots, just soak 120g overnight in water boiling water. Blend these with the water first before adding other ingredients.

#### **Kiwi Banana**

**Ingredients** - serves 2

1 ripe banana

2 or 3 kiwi, peeled

120g red or green seedless grapes

60g natural yogurt, kefir, or lassi


240ml unsweetened chilled apple juice

1-2 tbsp ground flaxseed or chia seeds

#### Method

Place all the ingredients into a blender and blend on high speed until smooth. Divide into 2 glasses and serve immediately.

Or try substituting other favourites fruits, unsweetened juice or liquids to find variations you enjoy. Add pitted dates or honey if you need sweetness.
